Objective Prepare students for management positions after graduation. Focus on two essential meta-competencies: resourcefulness and resiliency. Incorporate a combination of theoretical frameworks, practical exercises, and real-world case studies, so students will gain the knowledge and skills necessary to excel in demanding management roles and adapt to various challenges they may face in their careers.

Summary of course By the end of this session, students will be able to:

1. Define and differentiate between resourcefulness and resiliency in a management context.
2. Identify the key components and characteristics of resourceful and resilient individuals.
3. Understand the importance of these meta-competencies for success in post-graduation management positions.
4. Develop strategies to enhance their resourcefulness and resiliency.
5. Apply resourcefulness and resiliency concepts to real-world management challenges.
6. Evaluate their own resourcefulness and resiliency levels and create a personalized improvement plan.
